Materials List

- One (1) — Georgia-Pacific Plytanium® BC Plywood Panel, $\frac{19}{32}$ " thickness (makes 1—8' ghost)
- Jigsaw, sabre saw or similar power tool with plywood-cutting blade
- Transfer paper or carbon paper (at craft store)
- Large paper or grid paper
- Sandpaper or electric sander
- 3' strip of lumber or plywood, approximately 2" wide x $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick
- Four (4) 2" corrosion resistant screws
- Primer
- Orange, white, black, light green and gray acrylic paint
- Brushes: $\frac{1}{2}$ " and $1\frac{1}{2}$ " for solid areas
- 2" x 2" x 4' (actual $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ ") stake

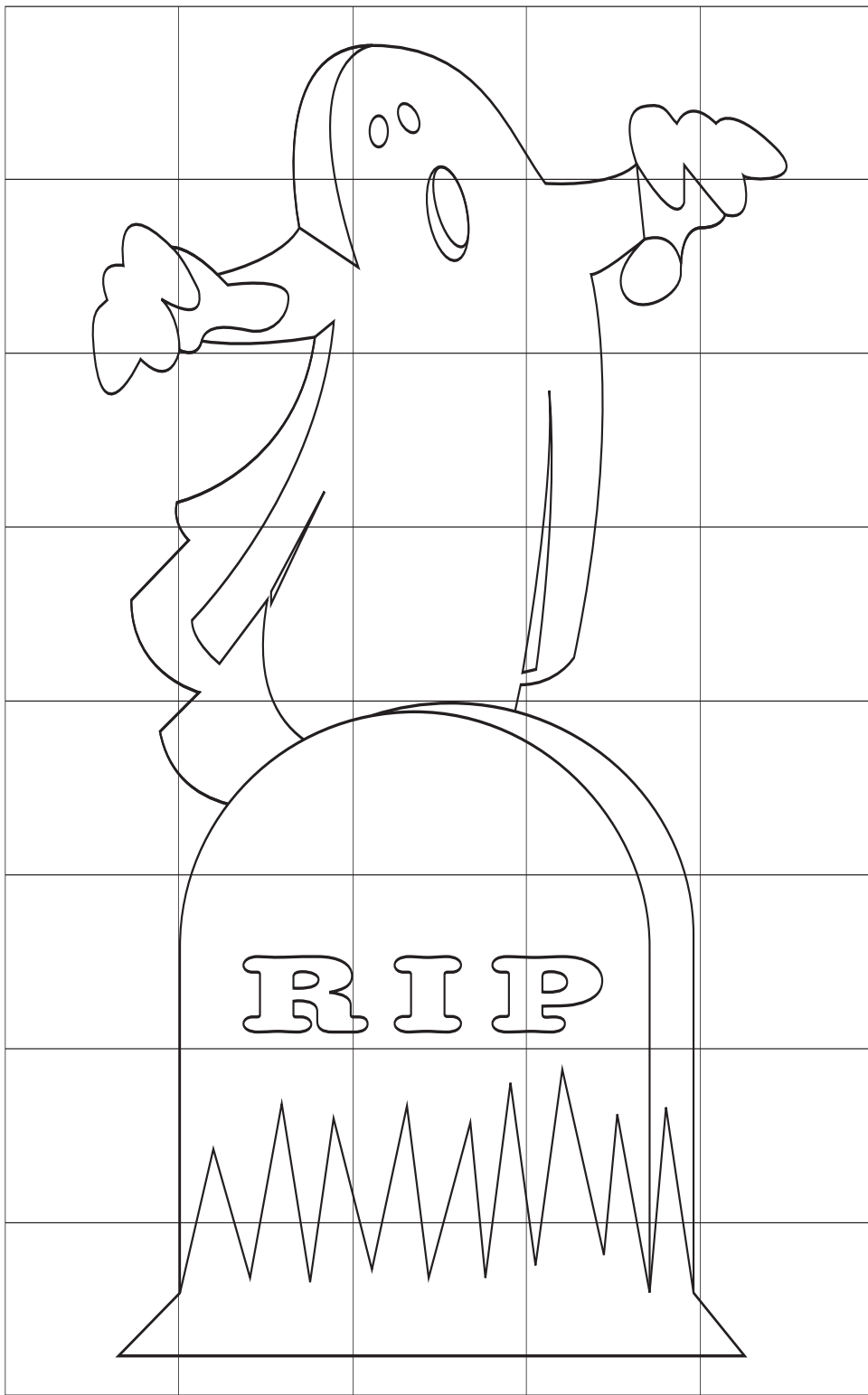
Ghost

Trick-or-treat? Get ready for Halloween by scaring up a ghost decoration for your front yard. GP Yard Figures are simple to create. This ghost is designed to be rewarding for a beginning carpenter; while more experienced carpenters will also enjoy this family project.

Directions

1. Select a 4' x 8' sheet of GP Plytanium BC Plywood; we recommend a $\frac{19}{32}$ " thickness for sturdiness and durability.
2. Enlarge the pattern to the actual size by redrawing on large paper or grid paper. Or, take this pattern to a copy service and ask for a 6x enlargement.
3. Transfer the pattern onto the plywood. Use pushpins or tape to fasten the full-sized pattern onto the plywood. Insert carbon paper or transfer paper under the pattern and trace the pattern with a ballpoint pen or carpenter's pencil. An outline of the ghost will be created on the wood.
4. Use a jigsaw with a plywood-cutting blade to cut the shape from the plywood. Support the pieces on sawhorses for easier cutting. Sand the edges with sandpaper or an electric sander.
5. To display the figure in an upright position, you'll need a stake cut to 4 feet in length. Center the strip on the reverse side of the cutout at a point 2' from the base so that it extends 2' below the base and attach with four (4) — 2" wood screws. You'll be able to anchor the figure firmly into the ground, using a hammer if necessary.
6. Choose your favorite colors of water-based latex paint to decorate your ghost and protect the plywood material. Apply several coats of primer, then paint the design. Be sure to paint the edges to prevent moisture from penetrating the plywood.
7. After the paint dries thoroughly, your ghost is ready to display and enjoy! When your yard decoration is not in use, you'll want to store it in a dry, protected location for next season.
